AWSA MIDWEST Hall of Fame

Established July 2017

Purpose: The purpose of the AWSA Hall of Fame shall be to honor and perpetuate the names and accomplishments of skiers, pioneers, and officials whose dedication and competitive achievements at State and Regional levels have brought lasting fame to the sport of water skiing especially in the Midwest Region. Permanent recognition on the AWSA Midwest webpage and a plaque will be presented to the inductee at a ceremony performed at the Midwest Regional Banquet. Inductions generally take place annually for those elected by the Hall of Fame Selection Committee.

Rules and Requirements for Nominations:

- 1. Any AWSA Midwest Member will be allowed to submit nominations to the Hall of Fame Committee.
- 2. Any nominations will need to be submitted in writing using the template (on the website) to the Hall of Fame Committee Chair. Verbal nominations and incomplete nominations will not be accepted.
- 3. Nominations are due by December 1st.
- 4. Committee will consist of the Regional Awards Chair as the HOF Committee Chair and the State Council Representative from each state.
- 5. If a state council representative is being nominated, the regional EVP will take their voting spot on the Hall of Fame Committee.
- 6. Not mandatory to be awarded every year.
- 7. Approval from of the state council representatives will approve the nomination.

Categories:

- 1. Competitive Water Skiers as recognized by AWSA
- 2. Water Ski Pioneers
- 3. Water Ski Officials and Technicians

Eligibility for Competitive Water Skiers:

- 1. Must be a member of one of the states within the Midwest Region for a minimum of 5 years.
- 2. Slalom, Trick, and or Jump Skiers are eligible.
- 3. Must have qualified for the regional and national championships for a minimum of 5 years.

Eligibility for Water Ski Pioneers:

1. This category is neither defined nor definable, but it is intended for people whose contributions to the sport do not fall into the other categories. Ralph Samuelson and Dick Pope, Sr. are examples. Those whose principal contributions are as water skiing officials should not be considered as pioneers. Individuals whose qualifications relate to the development of a specific discipline should be considered, based on the importance of their contributions to the sport of water skiing as a whole.

Eligibility for Water Ski Officials and Technicians:

- 1. The term official is intended to encompass a wide range of functions within the sport.
- 2. Primary consideration is given to contributions to the sport as a udge, driver, scorer, safety, TC, AWSA Midwest officer, AWSA officer, or any other AWSA Midwest or AWSA equivalent positions.
- 3. Minimum of 10 years of service to the sport.
- 4. Selection shall not be based on an isolated outstanding incident. Length of time in service, without contributing significantly to the progress of the sport is not sufficient. Emphasis is on achievements and not only on offices held or time served.

Qualification: Advancement to Regionals is based on the Ranking List. All skiers ranked Level 6 in any event or overall as of August 13, 2020 qualify for Regionals. At the Cut Off Date the Ranking List Average of the last ranked skier in each division in slalom, tricks, jump and overall will be established as the Cut Off Average (COA) for that division.

Last Chance Qualification: After the Cut Off Date any skiers not qualified via the Ranking List may still qualify for Regionals through 3 last chance qualifying methods (LCQs):

- 1. Increases your average equal to or above the COA any time after the Cut Off Date.
- 2. Record a score equal to or above the COA at any tournament class (C) or above after the Cut Off Date.
- 3. Place in the top 3 at your State Tournament.

Entry Fee and Deadlines: In an effort to receive earlier entries we will have a tiered late fee.

- *July 1st deadline \$105 1 event /\$120 2 events/\$130 3 events. \$275 family of 3, each skier > 3 \$80/skier.
- *July 2nd-July 26th is a \$25 late fee (except those who qualify after July 1st or anyone skiing on their state team, use code CCTCW in club member code to wave \$25 late fee).
- *After July 26th, additional \$10/day late fee on top of the above.

Remember entry fees are fully refundable for those who fail to qualify so we encourage you to register early.

SELECTION CRITERIA OR THE MIDWEST JUNIOR ELITE TEAM

The Midwest Junior Elite Team is selected annually at the Midwest Regional Championships and consists of 19 members. The team is selected from skiers in Boys/Girls 3-5 with at least one-year eligibility remaining. Selection is based on a formula that combines the NOPS score of the skier's National Rankings Average as of the current Regional Championship and Midwest Regional Championships performance. Each score is weighted at an 80/20 percentage respectively.

Eligible skiers will be selected from each division using the above-mentioned formula as follows:

- The first selection for Boys/Girls 3-5 will be the top overall skier.
- The second selection for Boys/Girls 3-5 shall be the skier with the highest combined NOPS scores for any two events, unless that skier has already been selected, in which case the skier with the next highest combined NOPS scores for any two events shall be selected.
- The third selection for Boys/Girls 3-4 will be the second-highest overall skier unless that skier has already been selected, in which case the skier with the next highest overall skier will be chosen.
- The final selection for Boys/Girls 3-5 shall be the skier from either division with the highest single event (S, T or J) NOPS score, unless that skier has already been selected, in which case the skier not already selected with the next highest single event NOPS score shall be selected.



When many college freshmen first set foot on campus, they're hit with a tidal wave of different activities and clubs they can join. While collegiate water skiing is present in regions across the United States, the Midwest Collegiate Water Ski Association (MCWSA) takes this sport to another level. Many skiers who are drawn to collegiate water

skiing have little to no experience, but they end up falling in love with the camaraderie of the region and make memories and friendships that are sure to last a lifetime, all while being competitive.

MCWSA tournaments are hosted by schools across the Midwest during the fall and spring seasons. The Team Midwest collegiate season is September-October, with spring tournaments coming not a moment too soon after a winter with little to no skiing. The MCWSA is divided into two Conferences, the Great Lakes (IN, KY, OH, MI, WV) and the Great Plains (CO, IA, IL, KS, MN, MO, NE, SD, WI). The teams within each conference compete in two regular season tournaments, then face off at a conference championship to determine who will move on to the Midwest Collegiate Regionals. The top six teams automatically move on to the Nationals tournament, while the next three are entered into a "wild card" tournament. Similar to past years, Team Midwest sent all three wild card teams to Nationals this past year.

While the winter and spring can be a little chilly, Team Midwest still finds a way to get together and ski, or at least talk water ski. Last February, University of Wisconsin-La Crosse and University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and the MCWSA, hosted the 23rd Annual Midwest Winter Conference. Similar to past years, teams traveled to hang out and learn from some of the best in the business. Zack Worden, Brittany Greenwood, and Cole Kalkbrenner talked all things water ski with Midwest Skiers. The month of May boasts its own national-level competition. Every region selects its ten best skiers by event and gender to compete on a "super team" against other regions. Dubbed the "All-Star Tournament," skiers earn their spot based on individual talent. Team Midwest had a solid showing May 2019 bringing the title back to the Midwest!

Due to COVID-19, our seasons in 2020 were not able to look like they normally do but our teams rallied and found amazing ways to recruit and team build while social distancing! We are very excited to get everyone back on the water competing collegiately in 2021!


